

Barriers to Employment

- Lack of understanding of the nature of weatherization
- Lack of competitive wages

Staffing

- Lack of qualified applicant pool
- Long lag time in preparing new employees

Contractors

- Contractor Capacity
- Contractors are not trained on weatherization requirements

Time


- 240-280 hours total paid time for intern
